



# **Books and Treasures Sale**

Our Lenten outreach project concludes Sunday, April 14. We are collecting items to support Family Promise of Hendricks County. Family



Promise transforms the lives of families experiencing homelessness and poverty in our area.

Items needed for their resource center in Plainfield include diapers and wipes, paper products (including paper towels, toilet paper, tissues), cleaning supplies, laundry supplies, kidfriendly foods (Ramen noodles, Cheerios, peanut butter and jelly, soup), shampoo and conditioner (full-size bottles are greatly appreciated), full-size bottles of body wash and lotion (no bar soap, please), paper plates and bowls (no Styrofoam, please), plasticware, and new underwear for adults and children. You can put your donations in the box by the organ.

Monetary donations are also being accepted. If we collect \$365, we can be a Thrive 365 donor. You can make a monetary donation by check to St. Augustine, noting on the memo line that it is for Family Promise. Monetary donations may be made through Sunday, April 14.
