Shifts are from 4:45 p.m. to 6 p.m., and 6 p.m. to 7:15 p.m. You can also volunteer to help cook sausage and set up for the supper Tuesday at 12 noon, and helpers will also be needed to clean up after the event.

Also, keep an eye out in the back of the church for tickets that you can sell to your family, friends, neighbors, and co-workers. You can return your ticket proceeds to the cashier when you come to eat at the supper, or you can place an envelope with your proceeds (marked for the Pancake Supper) in the church offering box. Prices are just \$5 per person and preschoolers eat for free. All proceeds from the pancake supper go to our Outreach Fund, which supports local charitable organizations.
