Holy Week and Easter

Holy Week begins with **Palm Sunday** (The Sunday of the Passion) on April 13. We will have palms and Holy Eucharist at the 8 a.m. and 10 a.m. services.

On April 17 at 6 p.m., we will have a family-friendly **Maundy Thursday** pitch-in dinner and service. We will provide chicken fingers and bread, and you are invited to bring a dish to share. If you plan to attend, please take a moment to sign up on the sheet on the front door of the church to let us know how many to expect. You are welcome to attend even if you haven't signed up. The service will include Bible readings and optional foot washing. This event will take place in the undercroft and everyone is invited.

On **Good Friday**, April 18, a service of the Stations of the Cross will be held at 3 p.m. An evening Good Friday service will be held at 6:30 p.m. This service will be live streamed on Facebook.

The **Great Vigil of Easter** will take place at 6:30 p.m. on Saturday, April 19. During this service, we will kindle a new fire and renew our baptismal vows. The service culminates in the first Eucharist of Easter in celebration of the risen Christ.

The good news of Easter will be celebrated with Holy Eucharist at one 10 a.m. service on April 20. Children are invited to attend a special Easter activity in the Apple house at 10 a.m. that morning. Our Easter egg hunt will take place after the service. Children are encouraged to bring Easter baskets for the egg hunt. We will have grocery bags available for egg collecting as well. The 10 a.m. Easter service will be live streamed on Facebook.
