Holy Week and Easter Services



Maundy Thursday, April 2, 6:30 pm

We will have a Maundy Thursday candlelight service. This is a change from what was previously published in our annual calendar. The service will include Bible readings from the Maundy Thursday lectionary and optional foot washing. The service will take place in the sanctuary.

The Great Vigil of Easter, April 4, 6:30 pm

During this service, we will kindle a new fire and renew our baptismal vows. The service culminates in the first Eucharist of Easter in celebration of the risen Christ. This service will be live streamed on Facebook.

Easter Sunday, April 5, 10 am

We will celebrate the good news of Easter with Holy Eucharist at one 10 am service. This service will be live streamed on Facebook. Children are invited to attend a special Easter activity in the Apple House at 10 am. Our Easter egg hunt will take place after the service. Children are encouraged to bring Easter baskets for the egg hunt, and we will have grocery bags available for egg collecting as well.

Upcoming Waycross Events

Beautiful Waycross Camp and Conference Center is located just over an hour away in Brown County. They have several events planned for families and adults. Camp sessions for youth are also coming up this summer.

Waycross's Spring Nature Retreat will be April 24-26. This peaceful retreat is set against the backdrop of blooming wildflowers and bird songs. There will be a mix of guided nature walks, hands-on nature-inspired crafts, and simple seasonal activities for individuals and families of all ages.
