They will have three Adventure Camp sessions this summer for youth who have completed 2<sup>nd</sup> through 8<sup>th</sup> grades. Activities include archery, canoeing, arts and crafts, games, hiking, swimming, tackling the ropes course, and Christian formation programming. Campers will also participate in an outdoor overnight that includes sleeping under the stars,
