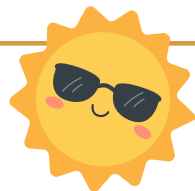

Sheltering Wings Needs

Sheltering Wings has a wish list for their residents' needs. Items wanted include Kroger, Walmart, or Aldi gift cards (groceries at the shelter cost \$250 a week), twin-size comforters and sheets, standard-size pillows and pillow cases, laundry pods, bath towels, disinfecting wipes and sprays, small-count bottles of over-the-counter medicines, adult coloring books, colored pencils, puzzle books, breakfast bars and toaster pastries, and individually-wrapped snacks, crackers, and cookies. Items may be dropped off at the shelter between 9 am and 5 pm Monday through Friday. Please note, they can only accept new items.
